Confirmation Policy for Sacred Heart Church

INVOLVED AND ACTIVE ROMAN CATHOLIC:

To be involved and active, Catholics must have an adequate understanding of what Confirmation is. They should worship at Mass on the Lord's Day, and receive Holy Communion when possible. In their home they should live in a Christian life, with prayer, and some popular religious customs. In doing this they provide a well-founded hope that their child will be brought up to live an authentic Catholic life.

QUALIFICATIONS TO SERVE AS SPONSOR (GODPARENT)

- One sponsor, male or female

Thus the church has established the following norms governing the qualifications needed to be a sponsor they must:

- Be sixteen (16) years of age.
- Be a Catholic who has been Confirmed and has already received the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist and leads a life in harmony with the faith and role to be undertaken. (Canon 874)
- Not be the father or mother of the child being Confirmed.
- Sponsor Form must be complete
 - with attached **copies** of all sacrament certificates *or*
 - signed off and sealed by your parish

** Canon? These come from the "Code of Canon Law", the living Law the Roman Catholic Church, appointed promulgated in 1983 by Pope John Paul II.*
