The Mass

The Holy Mass is when we come together as a community to unite ourselves together, as one Body in Christ. The third commandment states "Keep Holy the Lord's Day", which obligates us to participate in mass every Sunday with our community and family. Faith Formation Families are expected to participate in this sacrament every week. Mass is very important in our faith formation as Catholics, because we are united to one another and Christ through the mass by listening to the Gospel readings (the Good News of Christ) and sharing in the Eucharist (Body and Blood of Christ).
