

SACRED HEART CONFIRMATION YEAR 2

Confirmation Saint Project Guidelines

All Confirmation year 2 students are required to complete a Saint report.

Candidates are invited to pick a Saint Name for Confirmation. If they choose a Saint name their report is to be on that Saint. If they choose to keep their baptismal name for Confirmation, they are still required to write a report on a Saint of their choosing. All students will share their Saint project with their class. **The Confirmation name chosen is the name by which the candidates will be presented to the Bishop at Confirmation.**

One of the traditional practices in the Church at the time of Confirmation is choosing a saint name to inspire us on our Christian journey. Your prayerful reflection will help you determine that name. You might want to recommit yourself to your baptismal name, especially after you reflect on its meaning and discover some of the people who shared your name in Christian history. To help show the relationship between Baptism and Confirmation, candidates are encouraged to use their baptismal name. Or, you might want to choose the name of a saint who represents what type of Christian you wish to be.

Information on saints can be found at the public library, or Internet. Two suggested websites are www.AmericanCatholic.org and www.Catholic.org/saints

THIS IS WHAT THE SAINT PROJECT SHOULD INCLUDE:

Name of Saint (enough of a name to identify which saint since many saints have the same first name)

- ❖ Birthplace of the Saint
- ❖ Birthdate (if unavailable, note time lived)
- ❖ Important facts/information/details about the saint. How the saint lived his/her life. What is this saint known for? What virtues do you admire that this person has practiced?
- ❖ Is the saint a patron/patroness? Of what?
- ❖ List the saint's feast day.
- ❖ What about this saint inspires you to be a better Catholic and how is this saint a model for Christians today (why are they still important to the church and society today)?
- ❖ Why did you choose this saint?

FORMAT:

- *At least one full page typed double spaced (12 Times New Roman)
- *Cover should include title (Saint's Name) and your name and the date.
- *Must include a page that tells where you found the information (Simple Works Cited page with names of books, videos, or internet sources used)
