Ministries and Programs of the Parish

Pastoral Council

The Pastoral Council is an advisory committee that helps the pastor to establish a unified vision for the parish and to work toward specific pastoral goals.

Finance Council

The Finance Council advises the Pastor in his stewardship of parish resources. They review financial reports, approve the parish budget, and provide guidance in the allocation of funds for short and long term obligations.

Perpetual Adoration Program

In our Perpetual Adoration Program the parishioners sign up to make a holy hour each week in the presence of Jesus present in the Eucharist. The Eucharistic host is exposed in a monstrance so that parishioners can look at him and pray for the needs of the parish and the world.

Sick and Homebound

This ministry visits the sick at hospitals, convalescent homes, and private homes, offering prayer, Holy Eucharist, encouragement and friendship to those who are unable to attend Mass due to illness.

St. Vincent de Paul Society

The St. Vincent de Paul Society provides emergency food and other assistance to needy families and individuals in our community.

Little Shepherds of Mary

A club for Children to learn about Apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima, and to learn the Rosary by play acting the sense of the mysteries. Meetings are twice a month, May through October.

Children's Liturgy

During 10:00 AM Sunday Mass, children get to hear the Sunday readings at their age level and participate with songs and prayers. We welcome volunteers to help lead this program.

Lenten Soup Supper

Soup suppers are held each Friday during Lent following Stations of the Cross by the welcoming committee. Everyone is invited to bring a meatless soup, bread and cheese to share.

Meals Ministry

Parishioners partner with local homeless shelters to provide hot meals to our homeless brothers and sisters.

Catholic Scriptural Investigation (CSI)

Parishioners gather on Wednesdays at 7PM to investigate and reflect on the Sunday Readings.

CYO

The Catholic Youth Organization offers basketball and volleyball for children from 3rd to 8th grades of the parish. The youth are given an opportunity to learn teamwork and sportsmanship in a Christian atmosphere.

Sacred Heart Boosters Club

The Sacred Heart Booster Club is a group of individuals consisting of parents whose children participate in any CYO sport, through their efforts funds are generated to support Sacred Heart Sports.

Women's Bible Study

The Women's Bible Study is a vibrant group of Catholic women seeking to expand their knowledge and understanding of their faith! The group has two, 6-8 week sessions per year and meets in the parish chapel on Thursdays, from 1-2:30 p.m. All women are welcome!

Our Lady of Fatima Society

The Our Lady of Fatima Society was established in 1969 to preserve the culture and faith of the Portuguese people. The society provides various fundraisers throughout the year, assisting the Parish by sponsoring projects and events that benefit our community. Their annual celebration in honor of Our Lady of Fatima is on the first Sunday of October.

Knights of Columbus

The Knights of Columbus is an international organization of Catholic men committed to serving our parish and the wider community.

Altar Guild and Linen Committee

The Altar Linen Ministry purifies and launders the cloths and linens used at Mass. Those involved in this ministry are scheduled about once a month to pick-up the linens and return them to the Sacristy once they are cleaned and pressed.

Third Order Carmelites

The Lay Carmelites meet weekly to learn the spirituality of the Carmelite saints by prayer and study.

Lauds

Liturgy of the Hours is the official prayer of the Catholic Church offered at various times of the day and recited by the clergy, religious orders, and laity. Morning Prayer (Lauds) is part of Liturgy of the Hours and is prayed here at the Sacred Heart Chapel, Monday through Friday 6:50 to 7:10 a.m. Come join us.

Sacred Heart Spring Festival

This annual event takes place the third weekend in May each year. This gathering is a time to bring our School and Church Ministries together into one community.

Music Ministry

Music is an integral part of the celebration of any liturgical event. Our Music Ministry program offers a variety of musical experiences for parishioners of all ages. We welcome new members to Adult Choir, Youth & Young Adult Choir, Youth Band, and Spanish Children Choir.

Hospitality Committee

The purpose of this ministry is to welcome all parishioners and visitors to Mass and also host any special receptions required by the parish.

Contribution Counters

The Contribution Counters process all donations to our parish given at weekend and Holy Day Masses. This involves opening the collection envelopes, confirming the amount enclosed and ensuring that each parishioner is properly credited with their donation. Counters are parishioners who are appointed by the pastor and overseen by the Director of Finance. Counters help weekly for about two to three hours.

Church Cleaning Ministry

The Cleaning Ministry gathers in the church every Monday morning after the 8:00 AM Mass to clean the house of God. Serving on this ministry team is an opportunity to create fellowship with others as well as with the Lord.

Grounds Ministry

These individuals volunteer to help clean and maintain the grounds around our Church. They joyfully serve God by helping to keep the outdoor areas of our Church clean, tidy and beautiful.

Building Committee

This group meets on a regular basis to advise the pastor about building projects and other improvements of our parish grounds. They use their expertise to help set long term goals for the needs of the Parish.

Sacristy Ministry

The Ministry of Sacristans is dedicated to the care and maintenance of sacred vessels and liturgical furnishings.

Vacation Bible School

Each summer we offer one week of VBS to all children ages 5 years to 11 years. There are Bible Stories, Music, Games and Crafts which help the children make new friends and learn about the love of God.

Feast of the Sacred Heart "The Patron of Our Parish"

This celebration always takes place on the Feast of the Sacred Heart during the month of June. It is celebrated with novenas followed by Mass and a procession on the actual feast day.

Advent Giving Tree

Parishioners celebrate the true meaning of Christmas by taking a paper ornament from the giving tree, buying the gift and returning it gift-wrapped so that it can be delivered to one of the elderly, sick and homebound members of our parish family.

Rosary Ministry

This ministry makes knotted Rosaries for hospital patients, missionary trips, First Communions, and other special events.

Prayer Shawl Ministry

Parishioners knit and crochet Prayer Shawls. These are blessed by a Priest, and then given to people who are ill or enduring tough times.
